

Livingston County Republican Party – Official Convention Rules for the January | 30, 2025, Livingston County Republican Convention.

- The Livingston County Republican Party (LCRP) County Convention will be held on January 30, 2025 per the rules governed by the Michigan Republican Party (MRP), LCRP Bylaws, and Robert's Rules of Order, 12th Edition.
- 2. Per MRP rules, only duly elected Precinct Delegates, Delegates appointed during the August 2024 and December 2024 County Conventions, and those designated "Delegates-at-Large" shall be allowed to vote in matters presented at the January 30, 2025, LCRP County Convention. "Delegates-at-Large" consist of the most recent Republican nominees for State legislature and County office, Republican incumbent members of State legislature and County office, the Michigan Congressional delegation, Republican statewide officeholders, the Republican National Committeeman and National Committeewoman from Michigan, any MRP party officers, and the 7 voting members of the State Committee of the 13 Congressional Districts who reside in our county.
- Per MRP and LCRP Rules, there shall be no proxy voting. Delegates must be physically present to vote, and all voting must take place inside the convention room.
- 4. A secret ballot method shall be used for voting. The proposed manner of voting for 63 Delegates and 63 Alternates to the February 21-22, <u>2025</u> State Convention has been approved by the LCRP Executive Committee during a previous Executive Committee meeting. The voting method that was approved is Association Voting online, https://vote.associationvoting.com/lcqop/. Ballot(s) will not be available until voting opens.
- 5. The first round of voting shall be to select 63 Delegates to participate In the State Convention on February 21-22, 2025 to be held at the Huntington Place Convention Hall in Detroit, MI. Each eligible Delegate may vote for up to 63 persons on the ballot. If there is a tie for the 63rd spot, a draw of numbers shall decide who receives the last delegate position.
- 6. The second round of voting shall be to select the 63 Alternates to the State Convention. The ballot for Alternates shall consist of those who were on the first ballot but were not among the 63 <u>Delegates</u> voted to participate in the February 21-22, <u>2025</u> State Convention in round one. Each eligible Delegate may vote for up to 63 persons on the <u>second round</u> ballot. Ties in votes shall be broken by a draw of numbers or by mutual consent.
- The LCRP will close the ballot on Sunday, January 26th by 8pm. The official ballot will be published on our website by 8pm on Tuesday, January 28th, 2025.
- The County Convention check-in will begin at 6pm on Thursday, January 30, 2025. You must show photo ID to receive credentials and be eligible to vote. <u>Convention</u> begins at 7pm.
