



Livingston County Republican Party

Official Call to the Livingston County Republican Party County Convention. There shall be a meeting of the duly elected Precinct Delegates and the At-Large Delegates to the County Convention at 7:00pm on Thursday, January 30, 2025 at Floodgate Church, 1535 N Old US 23, Howell, MI 48843. Registration begins at 6pm.

The purpose of this meeting shall be to elect 63 Delegates and 63 Alternates to the February 21-22, 2025 State Convention which will be held at the Huntington Place Convention Hall in the City of Detroit.

The purpose of the State Convention is:

to receive election results in the thirteen (13) congressional district caucuses of

1. 13 Congressional District Chairs (1 per congressional district) and the other officers;
2. 91 members of the Michigan Republican Party State Committee (one of whom shall be the Congressional District Chair), 7 per congressional district;
3. 13 Convention Vice Chairs (1 per congressional district);
4. 13 Assistant Secretaries (1 per congressional district).

AND to elect:

1. one (1) State Chair
2. one (1) Co-Chair (who, pursuant to Article III A of the Bylaws of the Michigan Republican State Committee, shall be the running mate of the Chair)
3. one (1) Coalitions Vice-Chair
4. one (1) Outreach Vice-Chair
5. one (1) Grassroots Vice- Chair
6. one (1) Ethnic Vice-Chair
7. one (1) Administrative Vice-Chair
8. one (1) Youth-Vice Chair (who, pursuant to Article IV A of the Bylaws of the Michigan Republican State Committee, shall, when elected, not have obtained the age of 25)

AND to transact other business that may properly come before the State Convention.

A convention committee has been appointed to recommend the process of electing the members of the Livingston County Republican Party Executive Committee. The recommended process is a secret ballot, with the deadline being **SUNDAY, JANUARY 26, 2025, at 8:00pm** for those wishing to have their names appear on the ballot.

Precinct delegates who were elected on August 6, 2024, those elevated to precinct delegate at a previous convention, and certain at-large delegates are given the preference to vote at the County Convention under Rule 2 of the Convention Rules. Those who submit their intention to appear on the ballot but who do not plan to attend the County Convention, must notify the Chair or Vice-Chair of their absence via email.

ONLY Precinct Delegates elected at the August 6, 2024 Primary Election, Precinct Delegates elevated at either the August 2024 or November 2024 convention, the most recent Republican nominees for County and State Legislative offices nominated at the August 6th, 2024 primary, incumbent members of Michigan Legislative offices, the Michigan Congressional Delegation, the Republican National Committeeman and National Committeewoman from Michigan and Michigan Republican Party Officers where such person resides in Livingston County will be seated and considered eligible to vote at this convention.
